Heartiest monsoongreetings to all my colleagues from IMA Goa.



MINUTES OF THE FIRST EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE YEAR 2019, OF INDIAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION (GOA STATE) HELD ON 7TH APRIL AT HOTEL HQ, VASCO.

IMA Goa State President Dr. Anil Mehndiratta called the meeting to order at 10.30am and adjourned the meeting for half an hour due to lack of quorum.

Goa State Executive Meeting started at 11:00 am.

Dr. Rajesh Patil (Hon. Secretary) Goa State IMA, presented the President's Medal to Dr. Anil Mehndirata. IMA State President Dr. Anil Mehndiratta brought the meeting to order. Dr. NP Savoikar (representing IMA Mormaguo) which was host branch welcomed the members.

The following members attended the Executive Commitee Meeting : Dr Anil Mehndiratta, Dr Rajesh Patil, Dr Deepak Kuvelkar, Dr Ajay Pednekar, Dr P Rataboli, Dr Sandeep Naik, Dr Shradha Patil, Dr Hema Mayekar, Dr Francisco Couto, Dr Amit Rokade, Dr Priyanka Sahasrabhojanee, Dr Narayan Savoikar, Dr Sachin Palyekar, Dr Kalpana Chodankar, Dr Surendra Verenkar, Dr Sarvesh Dubhasi, Dr Parag Sawant, Dr Suraj Prabhudessai, Dr Tejas Kamat, Dr Nishank Halarnkar, Dr Deepak Lotlikar, Dr Akash Arora, Dr Amol Mahaldar, Dr Purnima Usgaonkar, & Dr Uday Kakodkar. The MSN was represented by Kenneth Silva and Rochelle Fernandes.

The following members were asked for and were granted LOA :

Dr Shwetha Khandeparkar, Dr Madhuri Debsikdar, Dr Amey Kamat, Dr Yogita Walke, Dr G.V.Prabhu, Dr Shekhar Salkar, Dr Medha Salkar, Dr Prasad Netravalkar, Dr Jagdish Cacodkar, Dr Vijay Naik, Dr Sumant Prabhudessai, Dr Ashish Shrivastav, Dr Sudhir Shet and Dr Vinayak Buvaji.

Dr. Anil Mehndiratta gave his welcome address.

Dr. Rajesh Patil recited the IMA Prayer followed by flag salutation.

One minute silence was observed to pay respect to the departed IMA members, Dr. Arcanj Menezes and Dr. Arondkar.

The meeting proceeded as per the agenda circulated.

1) Confirmation of Minutes of 5th Executive Committe Meeting held on 16/12/2018 at Ponda. Dr Rajesh Patil circulated the minutes. The minutes were passed by the executive committee without any deliberations, it was proposed by Dr. Rataboli and seconded by Dr. Francisco Couto.



2) Adaptation of Goa State Secretary Report Presented by Dr. Rajesh Patil from January **2019 to March 2019.** The IMA Goa State Secretary report was presented by Dr Rajesh Patil Hon. State Secretary, which included all activities of local IMA branches from January 2019 to March 2019. The report was proposed by Dr Parag Sawant and seconded by Dr. Shradha Patil.

3) Correspondance from HQ was presented by Hon. Secretary Dr. Rajesh Patil. It was decided that Travel and Stay of the National Vice President will be borne by IMA Goa State.

3) State Matters

Life Membership fees collected up to 7/4/2019 with old applicable rates would be dispatched to HQ. New fee structure from 8/4/2019 will be adopted.

4) Project cell reports.

a) Dr. Purnima Usgaonkar briefed on activities of Woman Doctors Wing and also gave details of EVECON and WIMALS which will be organised in Goa and hosted by WDW Goa, at Span Suite and Villas, at Siolim, on 22nd & 23rd June 2019 and urged more women to participate.

b) Dr. Amol Mahaldar, organ donation cell coordinator presented activities of his cell and urged IMA to honour the 1st Deceased organ donor of Goa.

c) Dr. Suraj Prabhudessai, State Coordinator for DMC proposed the name of Dr. Sudhir Shet as Member Secretary of Goa State DM cell which was accepted by Executive Committee.

d) Video of MSN activities was presented at the Executive Committee meeting. President and members of MSN were invited to attend Executive Committee meeting.

5) GIMACON XXX1- Dr. Jayesh Savoikar briefed matters regarding GIMACON with a request for maximum participation

6) AOB- with permission of Chair.

1) Dr. Surendra Vernekar requested Goa Medical Council to do away with submission of Biodata and CV of individuals who give regular talks to which Dr. Rataboli (Chaiman of Goa Medical Council) responded that the data computerisation is in process and repeated information of the speaker may not be submitted.



2) MSN members from this year, as per directives of HQ have to contribute Rs. 100 annually for Membership. Bank account for the same is in process of being opened.

3) Banker account for WDW (Goa) is in process of being opened as informed by Dr. Anil Mehndiratta. Another account for EVECON and WIMALS is also being opened.

4) Dr. Sarvesh Dubashi asked about status of accredition of online CME. Dr Rataboli responded as not yet accredited.

5) Dr. Sachin Palyekar inquired about renewal of registration of various IMA Branches to which Dr. Anil Mehndiratta responded that most of the branches have already registered.

6) Dr. Rataboli asked whether Branch Treasurer can be part of Executive Committee meeting to which Dr. Anil Mehndiratta said that they can attend as invitees as we invite MSN and other cell coordinators. He also suggested Treasurer may be added to WhatsApp group.

7) State President Dr. Anil Mehndiratta wanted to know, how the funding of various cells to be done? Various proposals were discussed. Dr. Anil Mehndiratta suggested fixed amount to be given per cell for utilization. Dr. Sachin Palyekar suggested that 2 cells be adopted by each branch.

Dr. Anil Mehndiratta suggested that each branch can contribute towards the same. Dr. Sarvesh Dubashi suggested contribution depending upon its strength. Dr. Amol Mahaldar suggested 25% of delegate fees which is handed over to the State IMA, out of which certain percentage may be utilized on the cell.

Dr. Rajesh Patil (Hon Secretary) asserted that it is not feasible to hand over fixed amount to all 14 cells as accounting/ auditing will not be possible. Unnecessary expenditure will be incurred and certain cells which do not require funds may unnecessarily start utilizing funds. This will be a very difficult situation to handle in future as IMA Goa State is already burdened by various activities. The members decided that finance of cells to be kept in abeyance.

8) Dr. Tejas Kamat, Secretrary IMA Bardez briefed about DM India 1000day initiative for which he requested co-operation from State IMA and local branches to conduct various CME, Screening camps and medical rehabilitation of diabetic patients.



9) Dr. Rajesh Patil (Hon. Secretary) requested Presidents and Secretaries of local branches to send their monthly activities as simple document which is inclusive of matter and photographs on the last day of the month.

10) 1st Edition of IMA News was released by State Executive Committee 2019 and was distributed to all the members.

11) Dr. Anil Mehndiratta informed that IMA Margao will be hosting next Executive Meeting and also informed IMA Bardez to suggest name of 3rd Vice President.

12) A framed copy of the poster, titled "International knowledge transfer for improved Organ Donation - an Indian Experience, which Dr Amol Mahaldar had presented at the TTS Regional Meet, Istanbul, was given as a memento to Dr Kalpana Chodankar, who had collected on behalf of past IMA Goa State president Dr Medha Salkar.

7) Resolutions: Nil

The Meeting ended with vote of thanks by Hon State treasurer Dr Deepak Kuvelkar, followed by refreshments and lunch.










3. Other Activities :

"<u>SAVE THE DOCTORS</u>" -ENOUGH IS ENOUGH-

A dark day in the history of Indian Medical System was witnessed by the country on 11th June 2019. A mob of around 200 people brutally assaulted two young interns at the West Bengal Government run Nilratan Sircar Medical College Casualty after the death of an 85 year old male patient. One of the assaulted Interns, Dr.Paribaha Mukherjee received multiple grievous injuries including a depressed skull bone fracture and is presently fighting for his life in the ICU of the same hospital. The Resident Doctor associations of West Bengal quickly demanded justice for the incident from the State Government and effective measures to prevent such repeated assaults on doctors. However, the Hon. C.M. of West Bengal refused to acknowledge the genuine demands of the doctors and reprimanded them for protesting.

This set of a chain reaction of protests all over the country as doctors all over India are already being targeted similarly and it was high time that the medical fraternity fought for their basic rights – right to work and care for our patients in a safe and secure environment.

IMA became the torch bearer of this movement and was widely supported by a number of sister organisations from medical / paramedical / AYUSH background.

The IMA Goa State became the flag bearer of this movement in Goa and as per National Directives, organised a 24 hour doctor strike on 17th June 2019 from 6AM onwards. All non essential / routine OPD services were terminated, however Casualty and Emergency services were not hampered.

A Silent March was organised from Azad Maidan in Panaji till Old GMC Complex in order to create awareness amongst general public about the grievances of the medical fraternity.

The protest was supported by multiple organisations – The Indian Dental Association – Goa branch led by Dr Chandrashekhar, The Homeopathic Association of Goa led by Dr Domnic Dias, The Ayurvedic Association of Goa led by Dr Sneha Bhagat, The Goa Medical Representatives Association led by Mr Nilesh Bagkar, The Nursing Association of Goa, The Physiotherapy association of Goa led by Dr KetanBhatikar, etc. NGOs like Lions Club and Rotary Club members also participated.



The march commenced at 10 AM and culminated in front of the old GMC complex. The protesting doctors displayed placards and wore black bands on their sleeves to Dr Anil Mehndiratta, State President, IMA Goa addressed the gathering. This was followed by representatives of various supporting organisations addressing the gathering. Dr ShekharSalkar, Senior Onco Surgeon, Manipal Hospital, Goa also spoke on the occasion.

The staff of both district hospitals as well as Sub district hospitals in Ponda and Chicalim also supported the strike by educating the patients and their relatives who attended the OPDs at the hospitals about the reason for the strike and the ill effects of this illogical violence on the medical system.




